Ace responds well to aggressive cutting schedules and regrows rapidly delivering multiple cuts per season. Always play the winning hand with Ace alfalfa.

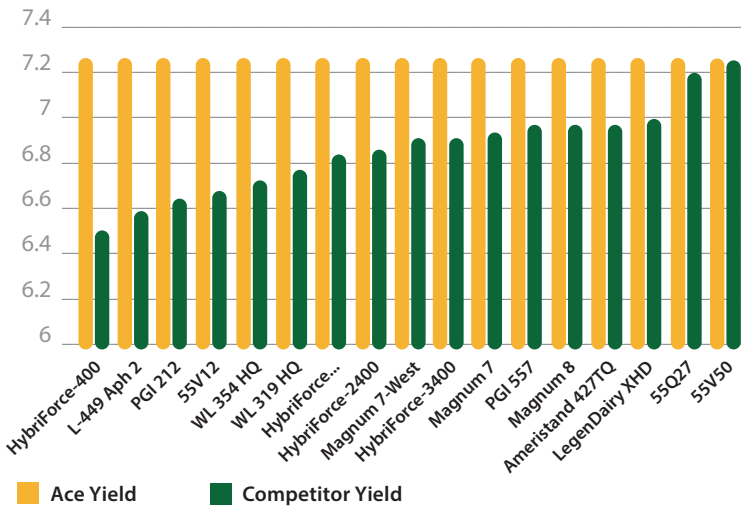
